

Q1 Are you an enrolled member of the Catawba Indian Nation?







Q4 Where do you live?



Q5 How many General Council meetings have you attended in the last year?



Q6 What issues keep you from attending General Council meetings? Mark all that apply.



Q7 How many times a year should the General Council meet?



Q8 Should the General Council have the power to propose new laws and changes to existing laws of the tribe?



Q9 What percentage of tribal citizens should be required to participate to approve laws of the tribe? (currently there are approximately 2100 voting age members)













Q15 Should there be term limits for members of the Executive Committee? And if so, how long should the limits be?







Q18 How should a vacancy on the Executive Committee be filled?



Q19 Should the positions of Secretary and Treasurer become two separate elected positions in the future instead of one person doing both?





Q21 Should there be an Ethics Committee created to ensure tribal leaders follow ethical rules until the tribe can create a tribal court system?


